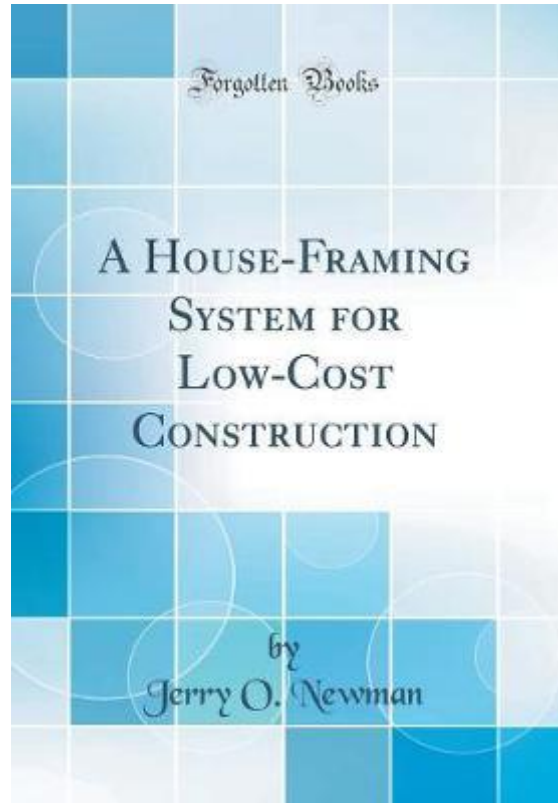

Pace in the house can be arranged in many ways; the floor plan of the prototype is shown in figure 2. The idea of using poles for both the foundation and the primary frame of a structure is not new. Some of the first structures built were of this type. The pole construction techniques have been neglected mainly because of the short life of wood set in damp soil. If the early settlers could have preserved wood products, as is possible now with a variety of chemicals, pole construction probably would have evolved as the primary building method for houses in this country.
