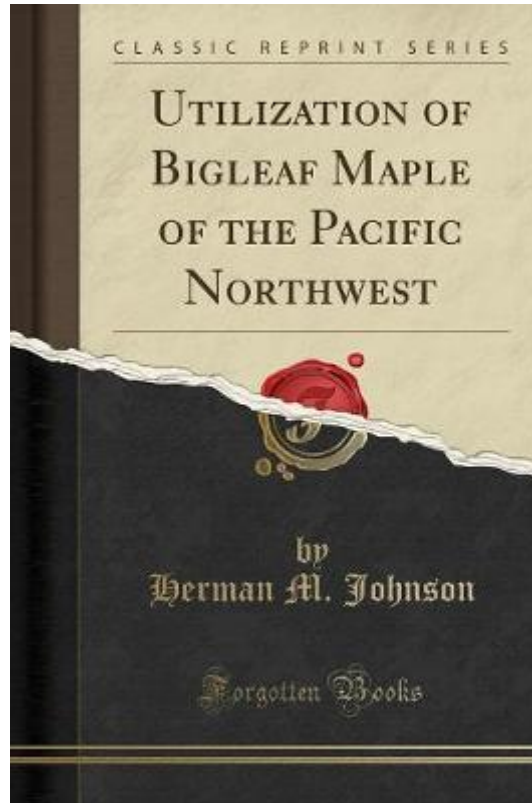

Even then the bole is rarely without bad crooks, forks, burls, or other defects, which reduce to a considerable extent the value of the species for commercial purposes.
